Info for WWOOFers

How to get here

We live near Redhill in Surrey. Most of our WWOOFers come from abroad. Please note, if you come from outside Europe, you will need a visitor's visa to stay here but this does not give you permission to work in the UK. See [WWOOF website](#) for more info.

There are four airports for London: Heathrow, Stansted, London City and Gatwick.

- LGW- Gatwick is nearest to us. Gatwick - south of London: train to Redhill.
- LHR - Heathrow - west of London; catch the tube to Victoria Station, then train to Redhill.
- LST- Stansted - north of London: buy a train ticket to Redhill, includes the tube across London.
- London City: tube to Victoria Station, train to Redhill.

Consider the cost of transport from the airport to Redhill, if we are your first host. You can find out costs on the web. If you are 16-25 years old, want to travel a lot and come for longer, [buy a Railcard](#).

We will pick you up from Redhill station. Once we have agreed on your day of arrival, just give us a phone call from Redhill.
